

2021 LHSLL Rule Waivers (Change 1)

The National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) 2020 Boys Lacrosse Rules Book will be in effect for the LHSLL Boys Lacrosse 2020 Season with the exception of the waivers listed below.

The Field

- **Rule 1, Section 2 The Field.**
 - **Article 1:** To the extent that is reasonable, teams are expected to mark fields with lines and dimensions as defined in this Article.
 - **Dimensions.** Due, to local conditions, dimensions may be altered to fit field.
 - **Lines.**
 - Except for limit lines, all other lines are required.
 - Delete NOTE and PENALTY, requiring a clearly marked center line that runs the entire width of the field. While it is desired, that teams follow this provision, even with temporary markings, so players can clearly identify the centerline, they are not required.

Goals

- **Rule 1, Section 3 Goals and Goal Lines.**
 - **Articles 1 & 2:** Any manufactured metal lacrosse goal may be used.
 - **Article 3:** A “legal goal” under this waiver is defined, as stated above, “any manufactured metal lacrosse goal.”

Helmet

- **Rule 1 Section 9 Player Equipment.**
 - **Article 1 (a.):** Mandatory Equipment: Protective Helmet.
 - Unless waived by LHSLL Commissioner: All players of a team shall wear helmets of the same color or colors.
 - **A.R.** At the time of this writing, the LHSLL Commissioner has approved one player (Newman Goalie) to wear a specially manufactured lacrosse helmet that is of a different color (white) than the rest of the team. No penalty for the different color helmet. This can be confirmed during coaches certification pregame.
